

+So where are we now?

- IHI Collaboratives ended in 2008!
- Deceleration of support seems to be increasing along with the performance/cost containment pressure on hospitals
- In-hospitals deaths decreasing
- Most DSA conversion rates > 75% and maintaining...We have sustained or increased our collaborative gains for >5 years!


National Conversion Rates

- Collaborative Conversion Rate


Percent of All Donors Recovered Through DCD

- Healing lives through protection of every potential donation and transplantation opportunity


Vision
