





# Q3 Do you feel as if UNOS takes your interests as a transplant professional into consideration when making policy changes or administrative changes that impact the community?



## Q4 What is your impression of why the OPTN/UNOS Membership and Professional Standards Committee monitors compliance and safety?



## Q5 As a transplant professional, how often does UNOS provide you with the information you need to stay current and compliant with policies?









### Q13 How long have you been involved in transplant?



### Q14 Indicate your level of involvement in OPTN/UNOS committees



#### Q15 Do you attend regional meetings?


